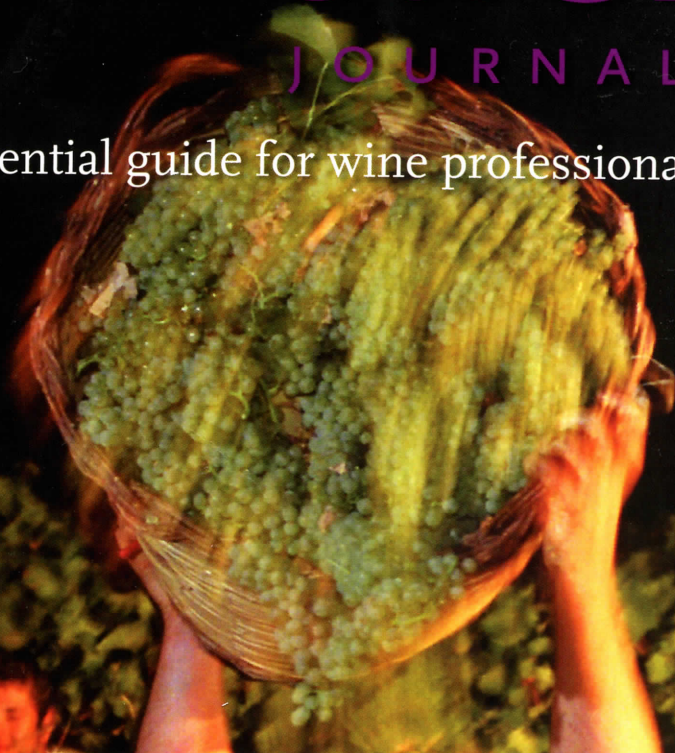

Honeyed Sémillon steals the show from the Sauvignon Blanc in a buttery Bordeaux blend—the perfect transition for a California Chardonnay drinker. Wet grass and lemon brighten up the breadly aromas of this viscous, golden-hued white.
