Chateau du Seuil Graves Red 2008

Hot on the heels of the excellent 2006 vintage, a jump to the 2008.

A little pepper and spice, blackcurrant, licorice, gentle smokiness. It's medium bodied with gentle but persistent graphite tannin, though it's the fine acid that really drives it along. Cherry and redcurrant flavours in there too, and a good lick of tannin cleans up the finish. It's not the most concentrated or deep of wines, though that forms part of its charm. It's expressive of its region and offers good drinking at a fair price.
